SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT LEGAL STATUS

The Constitution of West Virginia states that "The legislature may provide for county superintendents and such other officers as may be necessary to carry out the objects of this article and define their duties, powers and compensation."

According to the West Virginia Code "The Superintendent shall be elected by the Board to serve a term of not less than one, nor more than four years. At the expiration of the term or terms for which he/she shall have been elected, each Superintendent shall be eligible for re-election for additional terms of not less than one nor more than four years."
