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ADVANCEMENT THROUGH TESTING

Policy 2510 states that "acceleration is available for all students who demonstrate academic readiness for various delivery options". Therefore, it shall be the policy of the Summers County Schools to offer the following procedure for obtaining credit for courses and/or advancing to the next grade level based upon the demonstration of mastery of the content standards.

The parent/guardian will first make application to the building principal and present reasons as to why the request is being made via the SAT process.

Through the SAT process the SAT team will decide whether the student is a viable candidate for advanced grade placement.

The SAT documentation accompanied by a letter of request from the team and parent shall be submitted to the Director of Student Services no later than May 1. Requests received after May 1 will not be considered.

The student shall score 93% or above on a test of the content standards for the class/course.

The student shall fulfill any other requirements of the course syllabus such as lab work or writing a research paper.

The student shall not be allowed to take any test more than once.

Once the student is placed the placement shall not be rescinded nor will further placement test be administered.
