1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on August 13, 2018, 6:00 p.m. in the board office conference room with Mr. Stanley Duncan, board president, presiding over the meeting by phone with the following board members present: Mrs. Jackie Farley, Mr. Kenny Brogan, and Mr. Robert Angell.
